

- I. Finances
 - A. We have just under \$1,200 in the St. Albans Nordic bank account.
- II. Hard'ack
 - A. Snow fence setup will be organized after the first fall running series race, weather permitting.
 - B. Look into the possibility of grants to set up a lighted loop.
- III. Fall Trail Running Series
 - A. First three Sundays in November. Registration and timing are set up. The races will begin at 10 am.
- IV. Tuesday Night Race Series
 - A. Tuesday night ski night instead of races with the lodge open, with a \$5 suggested donation. St. Albans Nordic will have headlamps available to use. The proposed start date is 01/03/2023, weather permitting.
- V. NENSA Nordic Rocks Program
 - A. Provides free nordic equipment for PE programs. St. Albans Nordic could contact local PE programs and see if they are interested, connecting them with NENSA representatives.
- VI. Bootlegger Bikes
 - A. The bike shop that just opened in St. Albans. Perhaps host a local outreach event in the store and showcase local skiing opportunities.
